 - Robust – Content must be compatible with current and future user tools.

To meet accessibility standards, we:

- Use semantic HTML and appropriate ARIA (Accessible Rich Internet Applications) labels
 - Regularly audit our site for accessibility issues using automated tools and manual testing
 - Provide text alternatives for non-text content
 - Ensure sufficient color contrast for readability
 - Design for full keyboard and screen reader navigation
